Environmental Health Fees Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish a clear and consistent framework for the assessment and collection of fees related to environmental health services. These services may include, but are not limited to, inspections, permits, licenses, consultations, and other activities aimed at promoting public health and safety through the management and mitigation of environmental risks.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all individuals, businesses, and organizations that are subject to fees for environmental health services provided by Wayne County Environmental Health.

3. Fee Structure

Fees will be charged based on the type of service provided, the complexity of the service, and any other relevant criteria as outlined in the fee schedule (Appendix A). These fees may be subject to periodic review and adjustment by the governing body in line with inflation, operational costs, and changes in the scope of services.

4. Enforcement and Compliance

• Failure to pay fees or to comply with environmental health regulations may result in the suspension of services, penalties, and legal action as appropriate under Wayne County Environmental Health's regulatory authority.

5. Payment Terms

• **Due Date**: Fees must be paid in full by the specified due date as indicated on the invoice or permit application.
